“You can’t have innovation without permission to be wrong.”



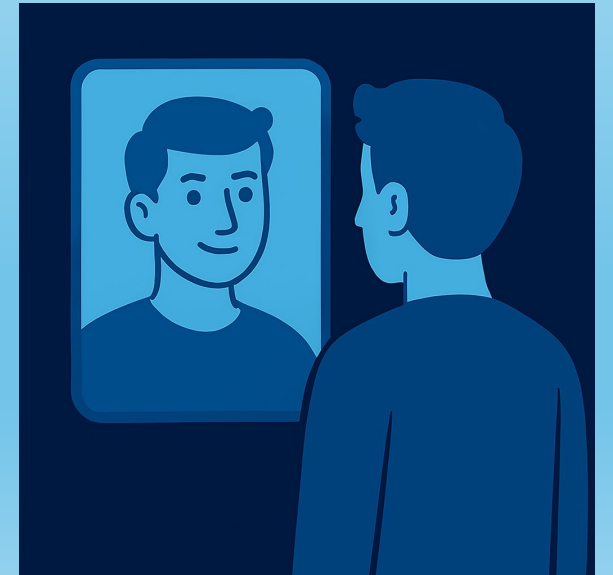
Real-World Leadership Examples
